Budget Hearing Meeting Minutes

Date: November 20, 2024

1. Call to Order --The budget hearing was brought to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairperson Jeff Faber. Present were: Chairperson Jeff Faber, Supervisor Kurt Haefs, Supervisor Robbie Pribnow, Clerk Sharon Belling, and Treasurer Marcia Valle. Also present were Randy Dittberner and Dan Griffiths.
2. Pledge of Allegiance – The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
3. Proposed 2025 Budget -- The 2025 Budget was presented for public discussion. The 2025 proposed budget is \$1,063,536, a 49.1% increase from 2024 due to additional revenues from the solar project. Total highway expenditures are estimated at \$781,853. The town tax levy includes \$32,203 in debt service for the new tractor and mower with total principal indebtedness for 2025 at \$31,418.
4. Adjourn – A motion was made by K. Haefs and seconded by R. Pribnow to adjourn the meeting at 6:37 pm. Motion carried (3-0)

2. Resolution #24-04 to adopt the 2024 town tax levy to be paid in 2025 in the amount of \$377,677 was approved by a 7-0 vote of the town electors.
3. Compensation for elected officials – A motion was made by S. Belling and seconded by K. Haefs to increase the treasurer’s salary by \$500. Motion carried (7-0).
4. Adjourn -- A motion was made by K. Haefs and seconded by R. Pribnow to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried (7-0). The meeting adjourned at 6:41 p.m.
